About the POSITION

CANCER FUND is seeking a candidate with a passion to make a difference. In this important role, you will build relationships with cancer patients, survivors, at-risk individuals, and the friends, family, health professionals, and innovators working to help them. Success in the role is measured by growth in our Screening Committee enrollment and engagement by Screening Committee members.

Our ideal candidate will be comfortable managing communications and community development efforts to engage individuals who are interested in supporting CANCER FUND. This role is primarily remote, however, Ambassadors will be expected to report progress at weekly meetings and attend events that are nearby, when in person events resume. Ambassadors should expect to spend an average of 2-4 hours per week; responsibilities may include:

- Create awareness and share the mission of CANCER FUND
- Identify, support and cultivate relationships with interested individuals
- Invite/register new community members and/or event registrations
- Communicate the mission and goals of CANCER FUND in the following ways: A). welcome prospective members and partners; B). engage with your current network; C). develop an

interested network through the distribution of developed content; D) help to develop content in collaboration with CANCER FUND.

Skills

Ideal candidates already have the following skills or are committed to developing them:

- Communication - Explaining the mission and goals of CF is your primary goal, so you must be able to communicate effectively, in many different formats
- Leadership - Motivates, manages, leads by example, manages stress & demonstrates patience. Coaches and develops employees.
- Social Media - You must minimally know how to use the major social media channels to grow a network, and convert those individuals to interested participants.

Qualifications

- Significant level of maturity and the ability to work as a team and to work independently interfacing with top company executives, senior management, clients, prospects, and co-workers.
- Highly organized, with the initiative and ability to work with limited supervision; excellent communication skills, effective network building abilities.
- Preferred candidates have the passion to help change the current landscape of cancer technology development and a capacity to consistently spread the message of CF.

Compensation - This is an unpaid role with the opportunity for a part-time equity only compensation position. Ideal candidates will dedicate approximately 1-3 hours to this initiative a week.
